**Directions to the Clem Miller Environmental Education Center –
Point Reyes National Seashore**

Description of the Facility

Located in a peaceful valley approximately two miles from Limantour Beach, the Center is used year round by school groups and adults as a living example of environmental education. Built in 1987, the main building contains a large dining/classroom area, an audio/visual/library room, a kitchen and a seminar storage room. **The kitchen is fully equipped with a large refrigerator, freezer, Wolf range, microwave, dishwasher, and cooking and eating utensils.** There is a central bathroom building with heated showers. While there are no electrical outlets in the restrooms, there is photo-sensitive lighting. Garbage is sorted and composted or recycled. There are five cabins which are unfurnished except for wooden bunk beds with pads. The cabins do not have electricity, heat or running water. The bunk beds can be uncomfortable for adults. You may want to bring a sleeping pad and an extra blanket for added comfort. The Education Center is wheelchair accessible.

The Education Center has no janitorial crew, so each group that stays is responsible for leaving it clean. During your stay, we ask you to clean up after meals and sign up for a chore to be done at the end of your stay.

In case of emergency, there is a phone at the Education Center: 415-663-1920. With a calling card you can make outgoing calls from the Education Center. Please know that cell phones typically do not work at the Ed Center.

FROM SAN FRANCISCO

- Go north on HWY 101 across the Golden Gate Bridge.
- Follow HWY 101 about 9 miles north of the Golden Gate Bridge to the Sir Francis Drake-San Anselmo exit (exit 450B).
- Make sure you're in the lane for San Anselmo (second lane from the right) and exit onto Sir Francis Drake Blvd. heading west.
- Follow Sir Francis Drake west approximately 21 miles - passing through San Anselmo, Fairfax and Samuel P. Taylor State Park - until it intersects with Highway 1 at Olema.
- Turn right on Highway 1 and proceed north about 100 yards.
- Take the first left turn at Bear Valley Road. Continue for approximately 1.3 miles, then turn left onto Limantour Rd.

FROM THE EAST BAY

- Follow Interstate 580 west across the Richmond-San Rafael Bridge.
- Shortly after the bridge, take the Sir Francis Drake Blvd. exit (the second exit after the bridge).
- Follow Sir Francis Drake west approximately 22 miles - passing through San Anselmo, Fairfax and Samuel P. Taylor State Park - until it intersects with Highway 1 at Olema.
- Turn right on Highway 1 and proceed north about 100 yards.
- Take the first left turn at Bear Valley Road. Continue for approximately 1.3 miles and turn left onto Limantour Rd.

FROM SACRAMENTO

- Follow Interstate 80 about 50 miles west to Vallejo.
- From Vallejo, take California Highway 37 about 21 miles west to the intersection of U.S. Highway 101 in Novato.
- Go north on U.S. Highway 101 about 2.5 miles and take the Atherton Avenue-San Marin Drive exit.
- Turn left onto San Marin Drive and head west for about 2.5 miles to the junction with Novato Blvd.

From Sacramento (continued)

- Turn right onto Novato Blvd. and proceed west for about 6 miles to the Point Reyes-Petaluma Road.
- Turn left and follow the Point Reyes-Petaluma Road southwest for about 7 miles to the junction with Platform Bridge Road.
- Turn right to stay on the Point Reyes-Petaluma Road and continue west for about 3 miles to the junction with California Highway 1 in the town of Point Reyes Station.
- Turn left onto Highway 1, drive south through Point Reyes Station and just beyond main street, turn right onto Sir Francis Drake Blvd, which is just after the green bridge.
- Take the first left (at the Y) which is Bear Valley Rd. You will soon come to the right turn for Limantour Rd.

FROM PETALUMA

- From Highway 101 take the East Washington Street exit.
- Follow Washington Street southwest about 1 mile to Petaluma Boulevard.
- Turn left and proceed southeast a few blocks to D Street.
- Turn right onto D Street, which will become the Point Reyes-Petaluma Road, and head southwest for about 15 miles to the junction with Platform Bridge Road.
- Turn right to stay on the Point Reyes-Petaluma Road and continue west for about 3 miles to the junction with California Highway 1 in the town of Point Reyes Station.
- Turn left onto Highway 1, drive south through Point Reyes Station and just beyond main street, turn right onto Sir Francis Drake Blvd, which is just after the green bridge.
- Take the first left (at the Y) which is Bear Valley Rd. You will soon come to a right turn for Limantour Rd.

★ Continue on Limantour Road for approximately 6 miles until you come to a sign (which is at the bottom a very steep hill) for the Youth Hostel and Environmental Ed Center. Turn left and proceed past the Hostel. Please note the sign for parking, half way between the Hostel and the Ed Center (at the Laguna Trailhead). After you have unloaded your gear, park your car here for the duration of the seminar, as the lot at the Ed Center must be kept open for emergency vehicles, if needed. (If the lot is full you may park in the grassy area on the side of the road between the hostel and the parking lot.
