Support Point Reyes National Seashore Association (PRNSA) by spending a day with three expert naturalists navigating the waters of the Gulf of the Farallones and Cordell Bank National Marine Sanctuaries. Our voyage will sail under the Golden Gate, head north past the Point Reyes headlands, pass through the prolific waters of the Cordell Bank (referred to by a recent event participant as the 'Serengeti of the Pacific'), and then sail south just inside the 100-fathom line of the continental shelf around the Southeast Farallon Island at the peak of the Great White Shark season.
