**FORMS:** All forms that require a signature are DUE BY April 1, 2008.

**REFUND POLICY:** Cancellations due to sickness prior to or during camp are non-refundable.

A refund (minus a \$50 processing fee) will be given on cancellations received at least 8 weeks prior to the starting date of your session; 50% refunds will be given on cancellations received at least 4 weeks prior to the starting date. If cancellation is received less than four weeks before the starting date of your session, no refund will be given. A \$50 processing fee will be charged for changing session dates.

**DROP OFF:** My child will arrive at camp at 10:30 a.m. on the first day of camp

I understand that if a parent/guardian is not the person dropping my child off on arrival day, that there will be a parent/guardian available via telephone during the drop off time (10:00a.m.-12:00p.m.) should any issues arise.

**PICK UP:** I understand that I am to pick up my child at 2:00p.m. on the final day of camp and that no child can be supervised by the camp after 3:00pm. Should the Camp Director decide to send my child home for ill health, I am obliged to pick the child up with no refund given. In the event that I cannot pick up my child on the last day of camp, I will fill out the Transportation Notice that indicates the name of the person(s) I have authorized to pick my child up if that person is not a parent or guardian. (The Transportation Notice is included in the confirmation packet and should be brought to camp on the first day **only if** the parent/guardian is not the person picking up the camper on the last day.)

**BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS/ CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATION:**

Point Reyes Summer Camp strives to offer a group experience and opportunities for learning within the boundaries of safety, common sense and the law. We reserve the right to terminate the participation of any camper without refund and without formal hearing who we believe has violated the conditions for participation, or become a hindrance to the group or goals of the program.

**ABILITY TO ENGAGE IN CAMP ACTIVITIES AND ASSUMPTION OF THE RISK:** Camp activities, including but not limited to hiking, canoeing, backpacking (in the case of 13-16 year-old campers **ONLY**: to hike an average of 6-7 miles a day with up to a 40 pound backpack), sleeping overnight "under the stars," tidepooling, and camp chores, can be physically strenuous and involve some risk to participants. Point Reyes Summer Camp (a program of the Point Reyes National Seashore Association) takes precautions to reduce risk and provide safe, healthy, and enjoyable experiences. I warrant that my child is able to follow directions for all activities offered at camp. I acknowledge that risks from participation in camp activities exist and that there are also risks from living in a wilderness setting. I have allowed my child to attend camp knowing of these risks and their possible consequences including personal injury.

**WAIVER AND RELEASE LIABILITY:** As parent or guardian of my child, I agree that I will not hold Point Reyes Summer Camp (a program of the Point Reyes National Seashore Association), its employees, officers, directors, agents and contractors liable for any personal injury, property damage, loss or insurance. I agree to release and hold harmless Point Reyes Summer Camp (a program of the Point Reyes National Seashore Association), its employees, officers, directors, agents and contractors from all liability incurred as a result of my child's participation in summer camp and that these terms serve as a release for myself and members of my family.

**OVER →**

IN CAMP TRANSPORTATION: Point Reyes Summer Camp provides educational activities for campers ages 7-16. These activities require that campers ride in an 8 or 15-passenger van driven by Point Reyes Summer Camp Staff. I acknowledge that my child will ride in an 8 or 15-passenger van during his/her week at Point Reyes Summer Camp. I agree that my child will participate in any activity that requires him/her to ride in an 8 or 15-passenger van.

PHOTOGRAPHS: Point Reyes Summer Camp is granted permission to use any group or individual photographs or photo images taken during a camp session for publicity or promotional purposes.

MEDICATION: If my child is bringing any prescription and non-prescription medications or drugs of any kind, including asthma medication, I will list them on the Health History Form. I understand that if I send my child with any prescription or non-prescription medications or drugs of any kind to camp, my child must bring them in original packaging/bottle that identifies the prescribing physician (if a prescription drug), the name of the medication, the dosage and the frequency of administration. I also understand that **both prescription and non-prescription medications must be provided in its original container or they will not be administered.**

I hereby authorize the Camp staff to administer first aid as well as to dispense medication brought to camp by the camper. All medicine is distributed by staff members with at least the level of Standard First Aid and CPR.

- Contacts/Eye Glasses: If your child wears contacts or glasses, please bring a second pair to camp.
- Asthma Medication: If your child has asthma - *even if s/he only rarely has attacks* - please bring a full inhaler or other asthma medicine to camp.
